

KINDERGARTEN

Dear Parents,

Many stores have good sales on school supplies during the summer and our Kindergartners will be excited about getting their school things. The following list may help you in doing your school shopping.

EACH CHILD SHOULD BRING:

1. A large book bag with FIRST & LAST NAME on it (no rolling bookbags)
2. A pencil box (cigar box size)
3. Crayons – 1 box of 24 or 48 crayons
4. Scissors – FISKARS
5. 5 pocket folders – not labeled

Each child SHOULD ALSO BRING the following items collected and used all year long.
Please bring these items on the first day of school, Thursday, August 13, 2009.

1. 2 rolls of paper towels
2. 2 boxes of tissues
3. 25 glue sticks
4. Markers – thick line, basic (“classic”) 8 colors
5. Yellow pencils, at least 1 dozen
6. 4 dry erase markers (not yellow)
7. 1 large box Ziploc plastic bags (ANY size)
8. Hand sanitizer
9. Paper bags

FIRST GRADE

Dear Parents,

We are looking forward to meeting and working with you and your child in first grade. It is an exciting time to explore new and wonderful things. During the year we will be stressing cooperation, with an emphasis on community in both our working and learning. The following is a list of the school supplies needed to prepare your child for a successful year.

We share supplies so please only label your child's bookbag and folder.

- Book Bag: one to bring back and forth everyday (no rolling bookbags)
- Pencils: 1 box of plain, yellow #2 pencils with erasers
- Eraser: 1 magic rub eraser (white)
- Crayons: 1 box of 24 assorted colors (**no glitter crayons**)
- Markers: 1 box of watercolor markers
- Glue: 3 large glue sticks (**no bottles of glue**)
- Folders: 1 folder of choice
- Ziploc Bags: 1 box of gallon or quart size plastic bags
- Kleenex: 1 large box of Kleenex
- Antibacterial gel: one 8 oz bottle of antibacterial gel
- Paper Towels: 1 roll

No pencil boxes, please.

SECOND GRADE

Please leave all supplies unmarked. Supplies will be collected and used as community supplies. Your child does not need a school box or binder/trapper keeper. Thank you!

- Bookbag: (no rolling bookbags)
- Pencils: 10-15 standard yellow #2 pencils
- Red Pens: 3 red ink pens
- Crayons: 1 box of 24 ct. Crayola crayons
- Markers: 1 box of Crayola broad tip markers
1 box of Crayola thin tip markers
2 black dry erase markers
- Glue: 6 glue sticks
- Erasers: 2 medium sized erasers
10 pencil top erasers
- Scissors: 1 small Fiskar pointed tip scissors (labeled with name)
- Folders: 3 two-pocket any design folders
- Notebooks: 1 wide rule spiral notebook
- Tissues: 1-2 large family size box of tissues
- Paper Towel: 1 roll of paper towels
- Coins: 4 quarters, 10 dimes, 5 nickels, 20 pennies in a small ziploc bag
(these will be used for math – please mark bag with name)
- Optional: 1 bag of individual wrapped candy (possible suggestions: Dum Dum suckers, Smarties, Sprees, M & M's, Snickers, Hersheys, etc.)
- Optional: 1 box of ziploc bags (quart or gallon size)
1 bottle of hand sanitizer

THIRD GRADE

Please leave your child's supplies **UNMARKED**. No pencil boxes are needed. Supplies will be collected at school.

Headphones: 1 inexpensive pair (you can get them from the dollar store or Deals)

Pencils: 1 pack of 20 #2 pencils

Markers: 2 dry erase markers

Erasers: 2 large erasers (not pencil toppers)

Folders: 4 two-pocket folders (2 red, 1 green, 1 blue)
1 two-pocket folder (child's choice)

Glue: 3 large glue sticks

Tissue: 2 large family style boxes of tissues

Boys: 1 pack of skinny Crayola markers
1 small package of napkins

Girls: 1 pack of regular Crayola markers
1 box of quart size Ziploc bags

Hand Sanitizer: 1 bottle

(no rolling bookbags)

FOURTH GRADE

The following is a general list of supplies used by our fourth graders.

4 colored pocket folders (red, yellow, green, blue)

3 choice pocket folders

4 one-subject colored notebooks – wide lines (red, yellow, green, blue) no trapper keepers

1 pack thin markers **(4CH)**

1 pack thick markers **(4CH)**

Colored pencils **(4W)**

3 red pens

12 #2 pencils **(boys only)**

1 zippered pencil bag (no pencil boxes)

1 pack of wide-lined loose-leaf paper **(4W)**

2 big pink erasers

2 glue sticks **(4CH)**

1 pair of scissors

3 boxes of tissues

3 dry erase markers, no yellow

1 box of quart size Ziploc bags **(girls only)**

2 bags of individually wrapped candy

Reading Supplies

- 1 – red colored pocket folder
- 1 – red wide ruled notebook
- 2 – pads of small sticky notes

Math Supplies

- 1 – blue colored pocket folder
- 1 – blue wide ruled notebook
- 4 – dry erase markers (no yellow)
- 2 – big pencil erasers

Science Supplies

- 1 – wide ruled composition notebook (science)
- 2 – glue sticks
- 1 – sharpie marker
- 2 – rolls of paper towels
- 1 – box of sandwich size Ziploc bags (girls only)
- 1 – box of freezer size Ziploc bags (boys only)

Writing Supplies

- 1 – black wide ruled notebook
- 3 – yellow highlighters
- 1 – pack green pens (boys only)
- 1 – pack red pens (girls only)
- 2 – 24 pack of #2 yellow pencils sharpened (NO MECHANICAL PENCILS)
- 1 – pack of wide ruled loose-leaf paper

Homeroom Supplies

- 1 – zippered pencil bag (no pencil boxes)
- 1 – pack of washable markers
- 2 – boxes of tissues
- 1 – pump of hand sanitizer
- 2 – bags of individually wrapped candy
